Our February speaker came with no shortage of credentials, TWA pilot for 39 years logging 28,000 hours in DC DC-4s, Connies, Convair 880s, 707s and 747s making over 1,000 ocean crossings! Not satisfied with his achievements at mandatory retirement, **Walt Gunn** obtained a doctorate in psychology and serves as Assistant Clinical Professor of Psychiatry at KU Med Center and Adjunct Professor of Aviation at CMSU. Dr. Gunn's mi careers have blended well to provide him with a prospective of human factors in aviation that is indeed rare. He emphasized the value of periodic physical exams and their relationship with safety. He was involved in substan abuse studies that now also include illegal drugs. Dr. Gunn pointed out that psychosocial factors often come int play in accidents, citing a number of cases where family problems, lack of training, different operational proced and poor maintenance were contributing factors.
